How to get to the Venue: Settlers farmer association's hall (Boeresaal)

From N1 North, take the Settlers/Codrington off ramp. Turn right on the R576 towards Settlers. After 23km, at the R516, turn right, away from Bela Bela/Sondela onto the P85. Follow this road for 5km to the Boeresaal on your left where ample parking is available on the Boeresaal terrain

ROUTES, PROFILES

The routes will be as follows:

- 🚲 **98 km route:**
 - **Start** in the P85 in front of the small garage, take the slipway Right and head Southeast towards the R516 for 5.8km.
 - Turn right at the 4-way crossing into the R516 and after 5.7km turn left onto the R516 towards Bela Bela/Sondela for 15.9km.
 - At the junction of the R33 turn right and continue for 36.9km.
 - Turn **right** onto the R516 again for 33km.
 - Turn left at the Settlers junction and continue for 1.2km.
 - Follow the road which then goes straight back to the **Finish**.
- 🚲 **50km route:**
 - **Start** in the P85 in front of the small garage, take the slipway Right and head Southeast towards the R516 for 5.8km.
 - Turn right at the 4-way crossing into the R516 towards Marble Hall and after 19.1km turnaround.
 - Follow the return road and after 19.1km turns left and continue to the finish.
- 🚲 **10km route:**
 - The **Start** in the P85 in front of the small garage, take the slipway Right and head southeast towards the R516 for 5km.
 - After 5km, turn around and follow the same route back to the finish.

Rules:

- 🚲 No helmet, no ride
- 🚲 No chip, no results
- 🚲 You will be required to produce your valid CyclingSA license at registration or you will be required to purchase an event license for R35.
